

# Before You Arrive



# What to pack

- Towels
- Tea towels
- Washing powder
- Anything you will need for your own snacks (cutlery, bowl, cup/glass)
- Can opener
- Snack food coffee, tea, milo, etc.
- Medication
- Shower Caddy/tote
- Jacket or Parka, maybe an umbrella
- Coat hangers
- Headphones
- Map pins / drawing pins for notice boards
- Another blanket or duvet if you think you might be cold
- Washing basket / bag
- Your favourite pillow

# What not to pack

- Toasters
- Heaters
- Grills
- Air Fryers
- Any cooking appliances
- Mini fridges
- Electric blankets
- Electric heaters
- Candles / Electric Incense
- Empty suitcases can be stored in bedrooms. If they are labelled with your name, suitcases can be stored in the floor cupboards, where space is available. But, please think about bringing soft luggage that folds up!



# Our Facilities

At Arcady we have 2 secure bike sheds, locked with a code that changes each year. You will be provided this code in your welcome pack.

If you wish to use the bike sheds, you will need to bring your own lock - a D-lock always works well 

It is first come- first served but please don't put more than one bike in there to ensure everyone gets a fair chance!



Our laundry room has 7 washers and 7 dryers (free to use!) plus a drying room and outdoor washing line. You can get into this room 24/7 using your key fob.


Remember - you have to bring your own washing powder and clothes basket! But, if you write your name on the side you're welcome to store it on the shelves we have in there. There are also yellow clothes bins you're welcome to use to transfer your washing from washer to dryer but please don't take them out of the laundry room!

# Testing + Tagging

All electrical appliances brought with you to Arcady must be test and tagged by a registered electrician or certified person for insurance purposes. We encourage you to get your items checked before you arrive as you will not be able to use these items until they have been tested and tagged (Mitre 10 + Bunnings both have it available!)

We will have a test and tagging service in the first month of your arrival for \$10/item for any new or untagged items. However, please note that the delay for getting items back can be up to a week!

Anything that will get plugged into the wall must be tested and tagged - this includes a multiplug board, new items and adaptors. If you're really unsure about an item, you can email a picture of it to [office@arcadyhall.org.nz](mailto:office@arcadyhall.org.nz) with your question and we can help you out 😊

# Check In

***Check In is open from 10am-3pm on February 10th***

When you arrive at the hall, follow the signs to Reception. This year, we ask that only the student enters the reception area and that you leave the rest of your move-in team and any bags in the car/the courtyard to help keep the check-in area uncongested!

At check-in, we will ask for your name and give you a pack containing your keys + some welcome documents. Then one of our lovely staff members will show you to your room (sometimes there may be a short wait during peak times - please be patient with us!)

Once you're checked in, your time is your own to unpack your belongings, settle in and maybe meet some neighbours! Please note that there will be a room checklist in your bedroom that you will have to fill in and return at some point today. Your move-in team are welcome to help you unpack, however please say your goodbyes before 4pm as this is when the resident programme begins!




# Parking

# First Floor Group Meeting
